4.0 Inspection summary

An unannounced inspection took place on 15 March 2019 at 13.25 hours.

This inspection was underpinned by The Health and Personal Social Services (Quality, Improvement and Regulation) (Northern Ireland) Order 2003, The Residential Care Homes Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2005 and the Residential Care Standards Minimum Standards 2011.

The registered persons of Fortview voluntarily ceased to operate the residential home and all residents were re-accommodated in 2015. The registered persons have yet to submit an application to cancel their registration and as such, are subject to a minimum of two RQIA inspections per year.

This care inspection was conducted give RQIA an assurance that the home remained non-operational.

4.1 Inspection findings

The registered persons of Fortview voluntarily ceased to operate the home in 2015. The residents were re-accommodated.

On 15 March 2019 we arrived at the premises at 13.25 hours. After introducing ourselves to a lady at the door we were informed that the home did not have any residents and was “dormant”. We are satisfied that there was no obvious evidence that the premises were being used as a residential care home.

5.0 Quality improvement plan

There were no areas for improvement identified during this inspection.
